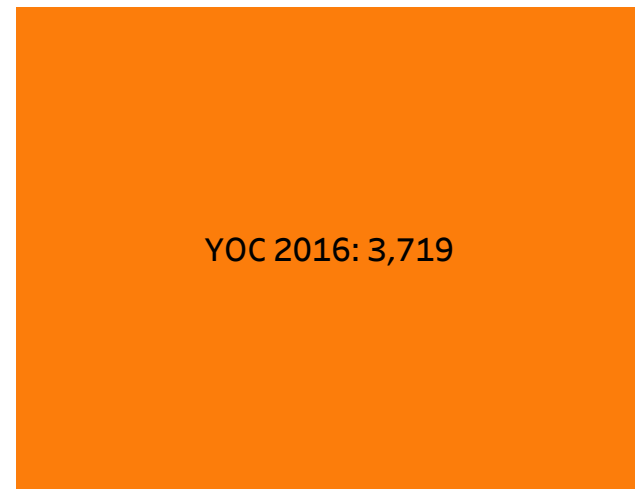

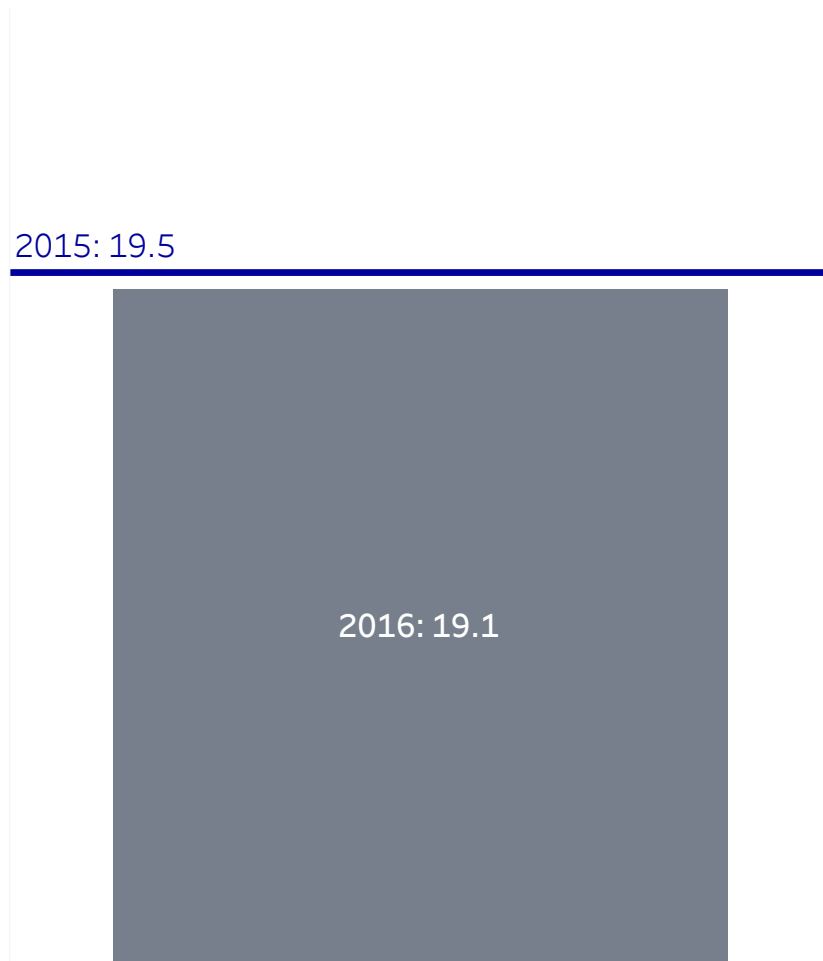

Average length of stay (ALOS) - 2016 v. 2015

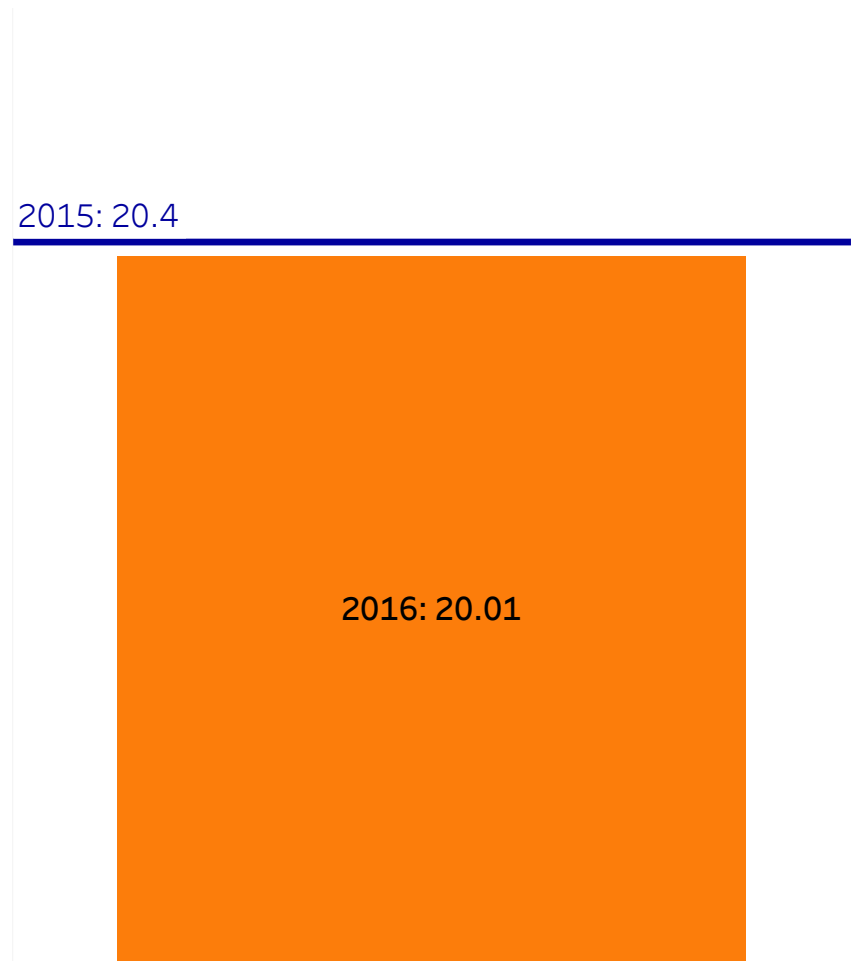

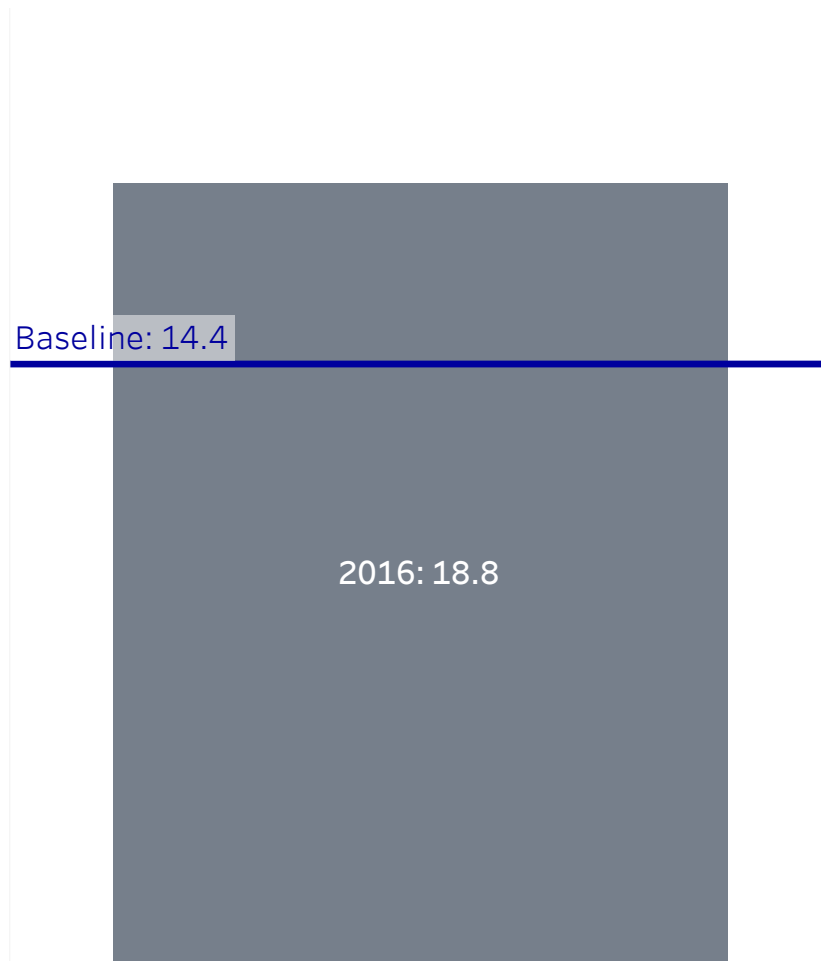


Average length of stay (ALOS) - 2016 v. baseline

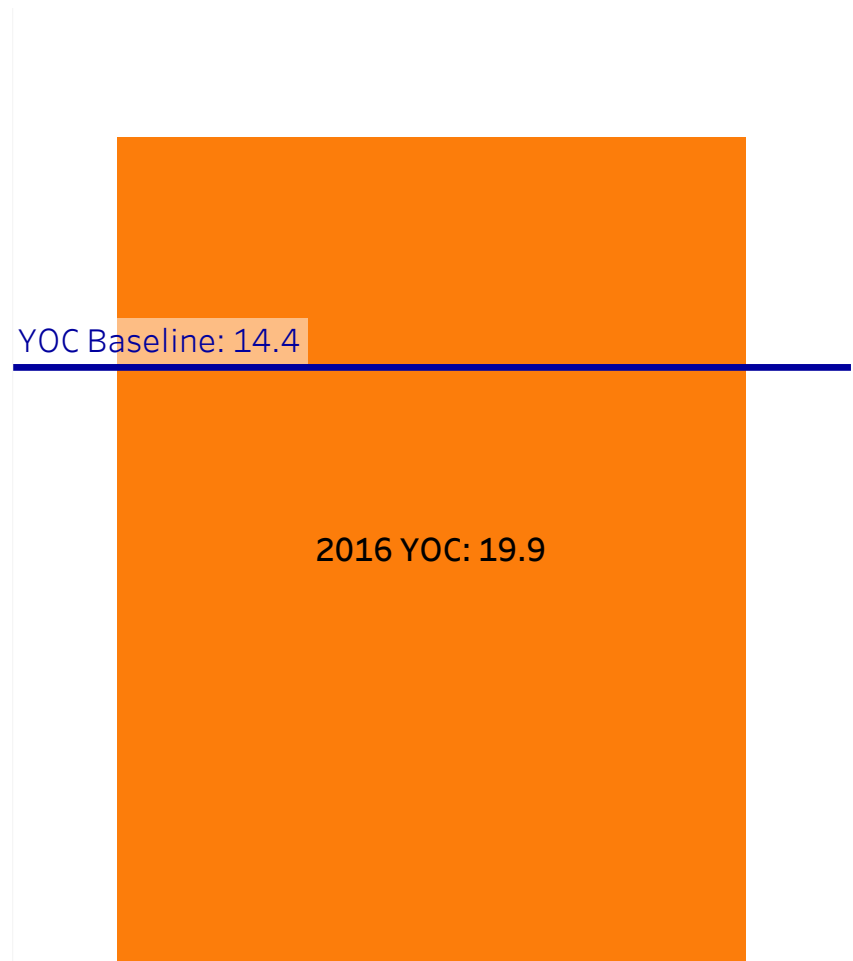

2016 YOC ALOS increased by 39% compared to baseline

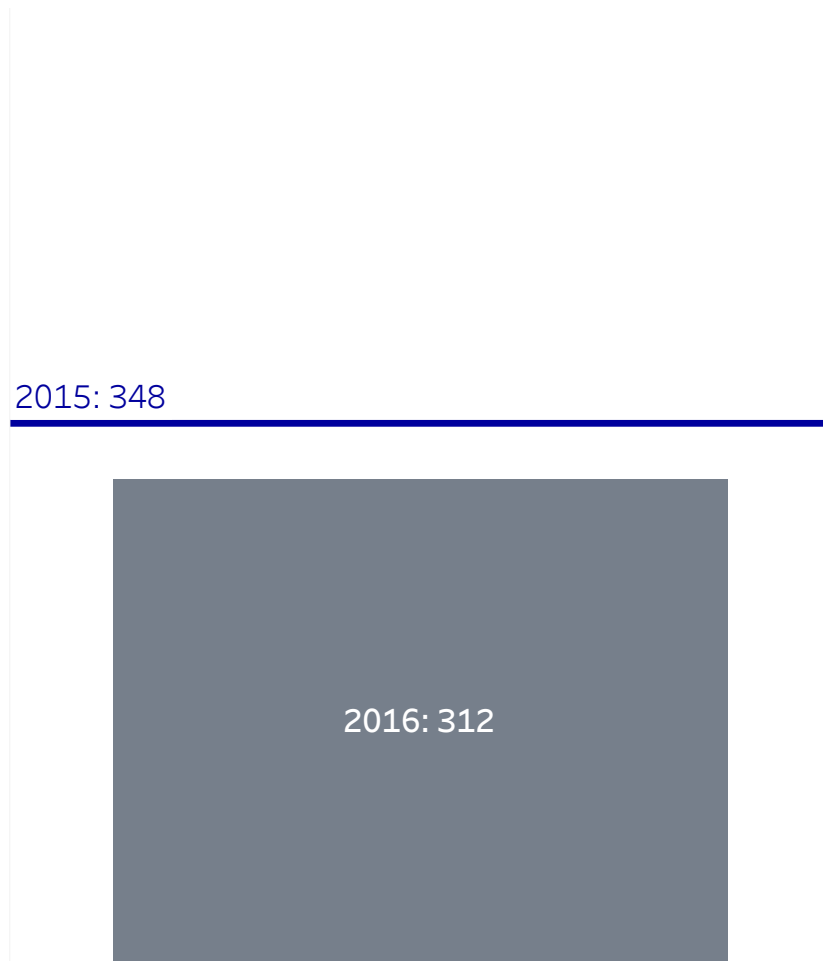


Average daily population (ADP) - 2016 v. 2015

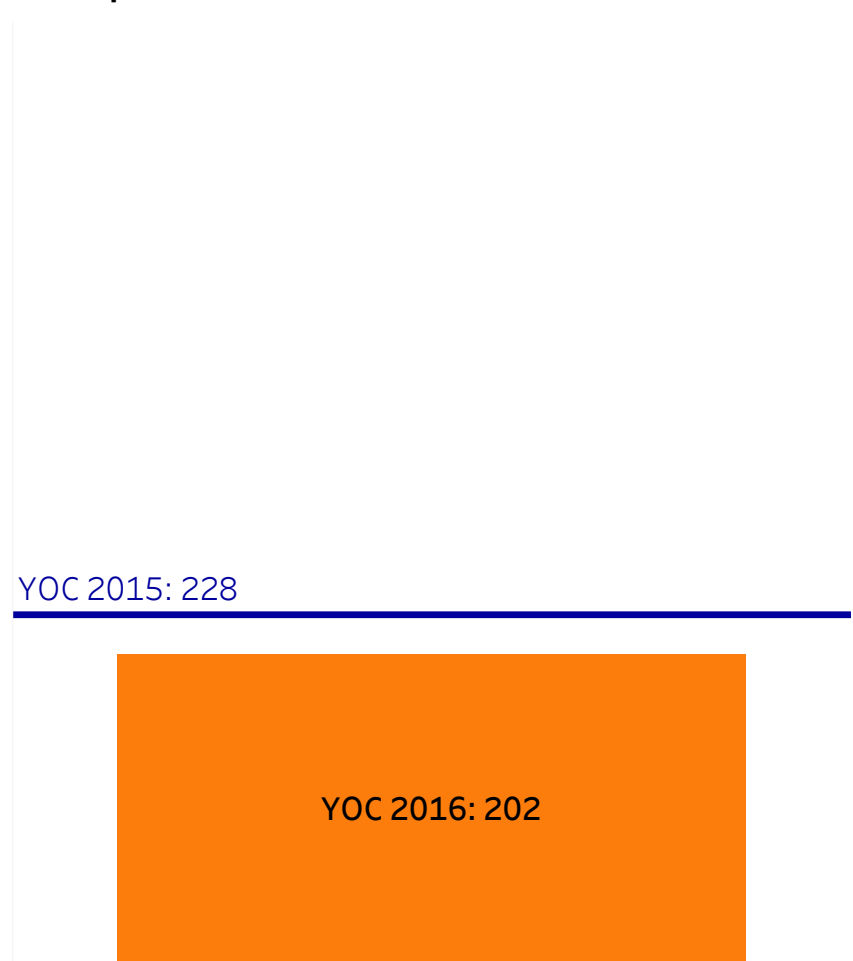

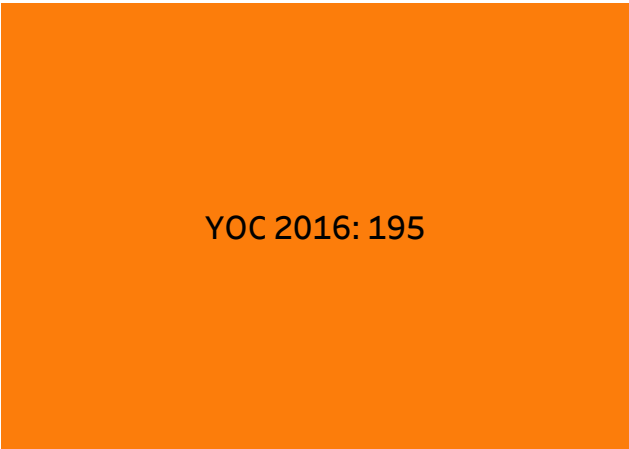
