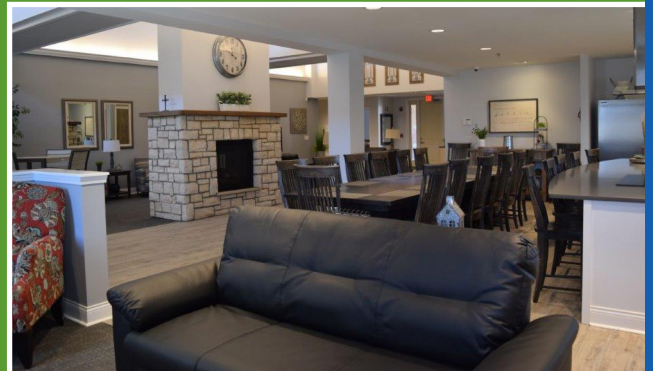
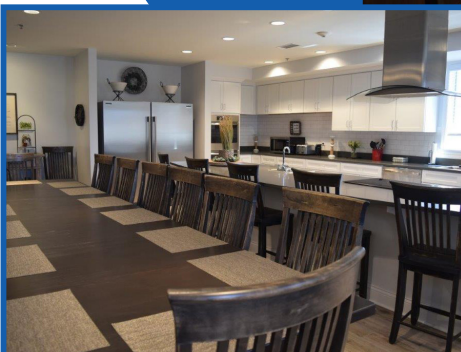
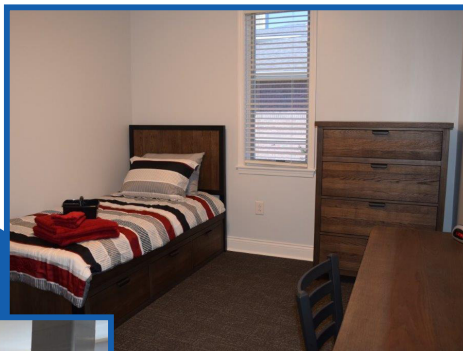
Hope Has A Home

Indiana United Methodist Children's Home uses the evidence based Teaching-Family Model, serving youth in a family-style environment. Those served are youth between the ages of 14-19 with emotional and behavioral challenges who would benefit from an open campus setting as a diversion from detention and secure facilities or as a transition before returning home.

Group homes accommodates 8-10 youth per home with each youth having their own individual bedroom.
