

Title: County Community Corrections Officer (This is a Grant Funded position)

County: Washington

Responsibilities:

Responsible for supervision of offenders who are placed into the Washington County Community Corrections Program (Day Reporting Program, Community Transition Program, Community Service Work Program). The work week is 34 hours. May be required to work one evening (until 8 p.m.) if needed.

Supervised offenders referred to community corrections programming consistent with the conditions imposed by the court, including regular face to face contact with clients.

Performs field contacts with clients in the community (home, school, work)

Completes pre-certifications and other reports as directed by the Court.

Maintains accurate records and completes data entry of all case contacts.

Completes risk assessments and develops case plans for each client.

Makes referrals to public and private agencies to meet the needs of the clients.

Maintains contact with agencies and other persons or institutions concerned with the treatment or welfare of clients.

Conducts drug and alcohol screenings with clients as needed.

Prepares reports for the Court and Prosecuting Attorney.

Testifies in Court.

Perform any and all job duties as required by the Judges, Chief Probation Officer and Director of Community Corrections.

Qualifications:

Interested applicants must be twenty-one years of age, be an American Citizen, have a baccalaureate degree from an accredited college or university, shall be a person of good moral character, shall meet all requirements for becoming a certified probation officer within six (6) months from the date that the Officer is first employed, obtain IRAS and IYAS certification within one (1) year from the date that the Officer is first employed, attend an orientation program conducted by Indiana Office of Court Services within one (1) year from the date that the Officer is employed, and be willing to complete a background check.

Education: Baccalaureate degree from an accredited university

Salary: Based on the Indiana Probation Officer Minimum Salary Schedule
