Turn right (east) and go ¼ mile to Priority Way (second stop light; Precedent office park's stone sign on corner). Turn right and go ½ mile through the office park to Indiana Wesleyan University. IWU will be a large glass building on your right.

From I-69 (south-bound)

Exit I-69 at 96th Street (exit 3). Turn right (west) at the top of the off ramp and go approx. 4 miles to Delegates Row (Precedent office park's stone sign on corner of stop light intersection). Turn left (south) and go ½ mile to Priority Way South Drive (first right past lake). Turn right (west) and take Priority Way 1/3 mile to IWU on your left, next to Walker Research.

From SR-31 (south-bound)

Exit SR-31 at I-465 east. Go 2 miles to SR-431 / Keystone Avenue (exit 33). At bottom of off ramp turn left (north) and go ½ mile to 96th Street. Turn right (east) and go ¼ mile to Priority Way (second light; Precedent stone sign on corner). Turn right and go ½ mile through the office park to Indiana Wesleyan University. IWU will be a large glass building on your right.
