

Topics and Presenters

This two-day training will provide the participant with an overview of current practices in the management and supervision of adult sex offenders in the community. The staff of Liberty Behavioral Health will present the training. Liberty Behavioral Health is the contractual agent for the Indiana Department of Correction Sex Offender Management and Monitoring Program that provides the Sex Offender programming within the Department of Correction facilities and parole.

This is an interactive training that will include break out sessions to acquaint the participant with risk assessments, polygraph usage, supervision techniques and containment of the sex offender under probation supervision. Each participant will receive a training manual that includes the following:

- all presentation materials
- pertinent assessment and testing forms
- other information that will assist in the effective management and monitoring of sex offenders in the community

Directions

Indiana Wesleyan University's Education Center is in the Precedent Office Park between I-465 and 96th Street, just east of Keystone Avenue, on the north side of Indianapolis. Most people have noticed IWU's reflective glass building along the north side of I-465, just east of the Keystone Avenue exit (exit33).

From I-465

Exit I-465 at Keystone Avenue (exit 33). Turn north and go to 96th Street (first stop light). Turn right (east) and go ¼ mile to Priority Way (second stop light; Precedent office park's stone sign on corner). Turn right and go ½ mile through the office park to Indiana Wesleyan University. IWU will be a large glass building on your right.

From I-69 (south-bound)

Exit I-69 at 96th Street (exit 3). Turn right (west) at the top of the off ramp and go approx. 4 miles to Delegates Row (Precedent office park's stone sign on corner of stop light intersection). Turn left (south) and go ½ mile to Priority Way South Drive (first right past lake). Turn right (west) and take Priority Way 1/3 mile to IWU on your left, next to Walker Research.

From SR-31 (south-bound)

Exit SR-31 at I-465 east. Go 2 miles to SR-431 / Keystone Avenue (exit 33). At bottom of off ramp turn left (north) and go ½ mile to 96th Street. Turn right (east) and go ¼ mile to Priority Way (second light; Precedent stone sign on corner). Turn right and go ½ mile through the office park to Indiana Wesleyan University. IWU will be a large glass building on your right.

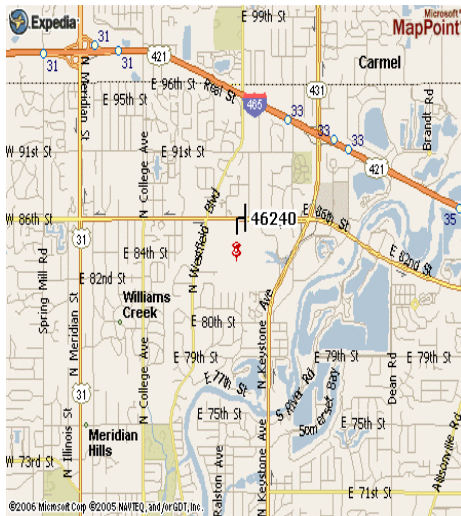
